

3344-15-03 University research council.

(A) The university research council shall consist of full members plus corresponding members

(1) Twelve faculty or staff members eligible under paragraph (B) of this rule, two from each of the six colleges, excluding the graduate college and the honors college. Eligible faculty and staff members shall be nominated by the deans of their respective colleges and submitted to the vice president for research.

(2) Three at large members elected by the faculty with graduate faculty status level at least a member of, and liaison to, the university research council.

(4) The regularly appointed or elected faculty members shall serve a term of two years. The vice-president for research shall make provisions for staggering the membership so that continuity is provided.

(5) Corresponding members: the vice

(C) The university research council shall be charged with the following responsibilities:

(1) Research policies. Review and report to the faculty, deans, and the president on new policies or programs designed to enhance research productivity and

(2) Internal funding programs. Review and recommend changes to the university's internal funding programs for research. The university research council will participate in reviewing proposals for internal competition, making the proposed recommendations for funding to the vice president for research.

(3) Bylaws of the university research council. The university research council shall maintain bylaws and procedures.

(4) Committees. Appointment and discharge of such committees as deemed appropriate. Committees may include members outside the council, including external members, when appropriate.

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
